The camp is held during the 2nd, 3rd and 4th of April 2010 at :

(located just next to the Copenhagen Grand Central Station)

There will be training sessions and seminars during three days and a banquet on the evening of Saturday April 3rd.

The camp starts with a training on the morning of Friday 2nd and ends with a short training on Sunday 4th prior to the departure of all participants.

The price for the camp including the banquet will be 100 EUR. Participants will have to take care of one dinner by themselves. There are hotels and hostels in the area and there will also be a sleeping hall close by the training area. Staying at the sleeping hall will cost 10 EUR and participants who wish to use this facility will have to bring their own sleeping gear, as mattresses or tatami will not be available in the sleeping hall.
